

# MEASURING AND ORDERING ARTIFICIAL GRASS

## MEASURING YOUR AREA

Our turf rolls are generally manufactured in 3.71m wide rolls x 20m long.

We advise sketching out your area and writing down the measurements for the length and width on your plan. Ideally, you want to lay the turf in an economical way, but also with minimal joins and with the turf pile all running/facing the same way.

## DIRECTION OF THE TURF

Most artificial turf has a pile that faces/falls in a certain direction. It is best practise when laying turf to have the fibres all facing the same way - ideally this would be towards your main entertainment area or where the grass will be seen the most from that particular direction. If this is not an economical way to lay the grass, then side on is your next best option. You want to avoid running the turf with the pile facing away from you - this results in the turf fibre laying flatter and therefore results in more shine visible on the turf surface.

## HOW TO ORDER

Turf is sold per lineal meter - 1 lineal meter is 3.71m wide x 1m long. 2 lineal meters is 3.71m wide x 2m long etc.

The turf rolls are generally 20m long and you can order as many lineal meters as you need - we can cut the length to suit but we can not alter the width. If you order over one roll, the cut will be made on the second roll:

For example;

If you order 26 lineal meters, you will receive a 3.71m x 20m long roll and a 3.71m x 6m long roll. 26 lineal meters equates to 96.5sqm.

We also suggest ordering an extra **5-10% for errors and wastage** - especially for odd shaped areas

## SAND

Once you have ordered the turf, you will also need to order the sand.

On average, you will need around 13kg of sand per sqm. So for this example, 26 lineal meters or 96.5sqm requires 1,254kgs of sand ( $96.5 \times 13 = 1,254\text{kgs}$ ). These are sold in 25kg bags so you will need 50 x 25kg bags of sand ( $1,254/25=50\text{bags}$ ).
